Performance

The Swiss Ornithological Institute will provide:

- 20+10 geolocator units SOI-GDL2, 10 GDL3-PAM and 10 μ Tags (all designed for *Sylvia* warblers and shrikes) by 2019, at a cost of CHF 100.- per device excl. tax (VAT, others).
- The units will be checked, programmed and sealed. A SOI-GDL3-PAM and SOI-GDL2 includes harness (see below), light guide and rubber coat. Life time expectancy of SOI-GDL2.x/3.0 is 8-10months at measurement intervals of 5 min; the expected failure rate is < 20%. (SOI will



replace each failed device by three. A failure is determined as data records did not last longer than the 50% of life time expectancy of the logger)

- Specifications of specific harness size must be provided by the client. SOI is not responsible for size and function of the harness.
- Data download, clock drift correction and conversion to text files is a service provided by SOI free of charge. Data will be provided to the co-operator within 2months after the devices and the accompanying information (ring-ID, sex of the bird, date, time and location of capture and recapture) had been received.

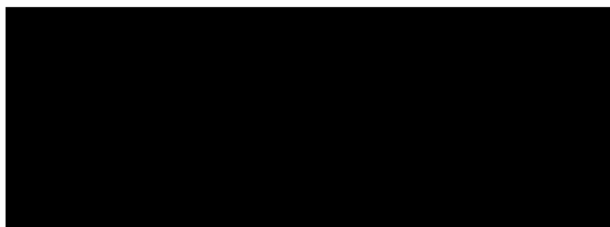
