PS: We do not travel with light guy. House lighty can use smokes, hazes, strobes, moving heads, blinders, LED-crap, 80's and 90's disco effects, and all kinds of strange things what ever you can imagine. Also bubbles. Oh and some front lights.

We use back drop if possible. Please make it possible. You can light it up as well.



Waltari plays versatile music. A good and powerful Pa-system and monitors are needed to reproduce the music clearly and without sound system distortion. Manufacturers of professional reputation are preferred D&B Audiotechnik preferred with Array Prosessing, L'Acoustic, Martin Audio... The system must be able to provide **loud** and non distorted sound for the whole audience area with huge low end.

#### ON ARRIVAL:

3 adult stagehands should be present 30 min before and during the whole load in and load out times informed beforehand by Waltari T.M. <u>unless\_agreeded otherwise between T.M. and promoter.</u>

#### FOH:

Analog or digital mixing console. If provided mixing console is digital the local engineer **must be fully skilled** to use it and be present all times from soundcheck to the end of the show. Contact Waltari FOH in advance about the console, might send a file.

**English** or Finnish **speaking** house FOH engineer, must be present during sound check and entire show.

32 input channel mixing-desk of professional standard quality:
Yamaha Rivage PM10/PM7, CL5, Allen & Heath iLive, dLive prefered
If analog, Midas analog H1000-, Soudcraft MH series with following outboard:
1 digital delay with TAP: TC, Yamaha... 3 x reverb or multifx
12 channels of compression: BSS, dbx, Drawmer, Klark-Teknik
4 channels of noise gates: BSS, Drawmer
1 stereo equalizer for tuning the PA: Dolby Lake, (Klark-Teknik)
Miniplug for iPod

#### **MONITORS / STAGE:**

We bring our own monitor mixer and IEM-systems with us.

We need analog XLR split for 16 channels, see Channel list. THIS IS

MANDATORY

Two (2) good quality wedge monitors with amps, like D&B M2/M4, Martin Audio LE1200

We bring some mics and DI:s with us.

We need mic cables and stands.

**NOTE!** A qualified, **English** or Finnish **speaking** experienced stage crew is needed. Also a PA-technician who is familiar with the system; both must be present and have the PA and monitors ready by the time of Waltari crew arrival.





Drummer throne with adjustable height, lockable bracket.

Cymbals (Sabian preferred, Zildjan or Paiste is fine):

Hihat: 14"

Ride: Sabian hhx or aax 22"

Crash #1: 16" Crash #2: 18"

1pcs. HH stand and 3 pcs. of boom stands

### Guitars SL & SR:

Gt. Stands: 2 pcs. of two-place guitar stand OR 4 pc. of single guitar stands Note: Stands must hold V-shape / Explorer-shaped guitars

### Keyboards:

- 1 x stand for 2 keyboard (double)
- 1 x stand for 1 keyboard (single)

### Bass:

1 pcs. of guitar stand for bass.

1 pcs spare bass, 5 strings.
