

PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT

between

Czech Technical University in Prague, Faculty of Mechanical Engineering, Department of Fluid Dynamics and Thermodynamics

and

ICPNAA (International Conference on Nonlinear Problems in Aviation and Aerospace)

GENERAL

In order to establish a partnership for organizing and hosting the 2020 World Congress in Prague, Czech Republic, **Czech Technical University in Prague, Faculty of Mechanical Engineering, Department of Fluid Dynamics and Thermodynamics** (hereinafter referred to as “CTU”) and International Conference on Nonlinear Problems in Aviation and Aerospace (hereinafter referred to as “ICPNAA”), hereafter referred to collectively as the “Parties”, agree to establish this partnership agreement (hereinafter referred to as “Agreement”) as follows.

SECTION 1 DATE, VENUE

The ICPNAA 2020 Congress will be held in Prague, Czech Republic from June 23-26 2020 at CTU (hereinafter referred to as “Congress”).

SECTION 2 NATURE OF PARTNERSHIP

CTU will host the conference, including all auditoria and conference rooms, cafeteria, coffee breaks, break-out rooms, presentation facilities and technical support, logistical coordination on site, including registration desk, welcome reception, printing of badges, provision of bags, paper, folders, pens etc. CTU will also provide dedicated on-site administrative support for the conference, in addition to the staff services including campus security, the university health center, and the provision of Internet connectivity for conference participants. CTU will also advertise the event locally to academic institutions, private sector in the realms of engineering, aviation, and applied science, as well as relevant public sector and governmental entities. CTU may secure local sponsorship in coordination with General Co-chair to subsidize the other costs on site. CTU will bill ICPNAA for the balance of the services rendered. According to the requirements of the tax law of the Czech Republic, the bill will also include the value added tax. CTU will provide travel support and Hotel accommodation for General organizers as well as for the coordinators of the conference.

**SECTION 3
INDEMNIFICATION**

To the fullest extent permitted by law, ICPNAA shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless CTU, its officials, officers, employees, agents and volunteers from and against any and all claims, demands, damages, liabilities, losses, costs or expenses, including attorneys' fees and costs of defense (collectively, "Claims"), including, but not limited to, Claims relating to death or injury to any person and injury to any property, which arise out of, pertain to, or relate to the acts or omissions of ICPNAA or any of its officers, employees, contractors, subcontractors, agents or Congress participants, in the performance of this Agreement. ICPNAA's duty to defend shall survive the expiration or termination of this Agreement.

**SECTION 4
GOVERNING LAW**

This Agreement is governed by and construed in accordance with the substantive law of the Czech Republic. In case of any disputes on matters under this Agreement, which cannot be resolved by an amicable settlement, the matter shall have to be decided in accordance with the jurisdiction of the Coordinator's country.

**SECTION 5
DISPUTE RESOLUTION**

Disputes of any kind whatsoever arising in connection with, or arising out of this Agreement shall be settled through negotiations. Each Party will maximally take into account the suggestions of the other Party. If no agreement has been reached between the Parties, the resolution of disputes shall be submitted for examination by courts of Czech Republic.

**SECTION 6
MODIFICATIONS**

This Agreement may be supplemented, amended or modified only by a writing signed by the parties.

**SECTION 7
FORCE MAJEURE**

Failure to perform the obligations set forth in this Agreement in whole or in part shall exempt the Parties from the performance of their obligations due to force majeure, which occurred after the execution of this Agreement, and which the Parties could not foresee or prevent. Such situations are: earthquakes, flood, war and laws/regulations, which may make impossible the performance of the obligations set forth in this Agreement. If the effect of the force majeure continues for more than 6 (six) months, the Parties have the right to terminate this Agreement by a mutual consent.

SECTION 8
FINAL PROVISIONS

Each Party shall be responsible for its actions and inactions in connection with this Agreement and its implementation.

This Agreement shall enter into force on the date the last Party signs.

This Agreement is signed in duplicate in the English language. Each party shall receive one copy
