- 2. Incoming students from our partner institutions are only accepted on the basis of a nomination by their home institution. Candidates will receive a link to the online application form and will be asked to complete the following documents: Application Form and Learning Agreement.
- 3. Students must obtain health and accident insurance coverage before mobility.
- 4. Incoming students may participate in the Welcome Week at the beginning of each semester.

5. Students with disabilities could be accepted after the consultation with International Relations Office.

Transcripts of records are issued by the International Office immediately after the examination period and handed to the incoming students before their departure

4. Termination of the agreement

It is up to the involved institutions to agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the inter-institutional agreement. However, in the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."
