Inter-institutional agreement 2019-20[21]<sup>1</sup> between programme countries



- 4. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HFI
- 5. Termination of the agreement: Each party reserves the right to extend, amend or terminate the inter-institutional agreement on the basis of reciprocity. In the event of unilateral termination of the agreement, either party should inform the other party in writing about its decision to discontinue the exchanges with a notice of at least one academic year, provided that such termination shall not affect the students nominated prior to the date of notification. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
