Annex 2 – Technical Requirements/ Special Conditions

The National Veterinary Laboratory (VPRD-MESDC) of Malta is outsourcing official analysis for residues on veterinary medicinals and contaminants in food of animal origin according to 96/23 for the 2019 programme.

Requirements:

- It is required that the laboratory performing such analysis is a National Reference Laboratory for that group of residues within its own country and that the test methods are validated and according to the current EU Regulations.
- Results are to be received within 28 days from receipt of sample.
- Test reports are to be issued per sample in English.
- The data resulting from these analysis are of the sole property of Malta and cannot be published in part or in full without prior approval of the competent authority.
