- Incoming students can study in English only fall term.
- Selection process: the partner university is kindly requested to ensure that the language proficiency of the outgoing student(s) is a minimum B2.
- the KSH welcomes students and staff with disabilities
- Services for incoming students:
 - Support in finding accommodation / student housing.
 - The obligatory Orientation Days are organized for international students each semester where students are supported (a) to arrive in Munich and to move into accommodation, (b) to fulfil the legal requirements of registration and health insurance, (c) to familiarise with

Munich and the KSH campus and its institutions, and (d) to get acquainted with the KSH local students

- Participation in a German language course (up to 6 ECTS) is possible but requires a fee of €140 (situation January 2020)
- The KSH mentor system ensures the acculturation of international students by organizing a series of cultural and leisure activities.
