
- A. Article 4 DECLARATIONS OF THE FACULTY is amended in Article 4.4(i) as follows:
The existing wording which reads *“Tuition fees are EUR 7 500 p.a. and shall remain constant during the regular study term“* is amended to read: *“Tuition fees are EUR 8 000 p.a. and shall remain constant during the regular study term“*

Amendment No. 1 to the Cooperation Agreement enters into force and effect on the date it is signed by authorized representatives of the Parties.


