(\*) There is no specific language level required, but it is deemed understood that students must have the necessary level to be able to attend lessons and sit exams. Minimum recommended level: B1

Students must register and complete an online application at http://sia.uab.cat/ (English), Students, Mobility and Exchange, INcoming students - Signing up and application form

Applications without the previous nomination from the home university will not be considered.

Once we have checked that the applications match the nomination data sent by our partner universities, students will receive an e-mail with a digitized copy of their Acceptance Letter and pre-arrival information.
