- Grantee must be and remain a public charity at the time of signing and if and when funds are disbursed.

Use of Grant Funds:

This Conditional Grant Agreement supplements the Master Grant Agreement issued on August 12, 2020. This grant is issued under the terms of the Master Grant Agreement.

This grant will be paid in three installments, up to the amount specified, in accordance with the payment schedule outlined upon verification of the special conditions. All payments outlined in this grant agreement are also subject to available assets in the Cisco University Research Program Fund at Silicon Valley Community Foundation.

Payment 1: \$100,000.00 upon receipt of the signed conditional grant agreement

Payment 2: Up to \$82,812.50 upon receipt and approval of Interim Report 1

Payment 3: Up to \$82,812.50 upon receipt and approval of Interim Report 2

The second and third payment are conditional on meeting the anticipated project outcomes and deliverables and must be in compliance with providing yearly interim reporting updates.

Hold Harmless
