Změna se týká bodu 2. Rádiová síť TETRA pro zajištění pokrytí radiové signalizace ve všech depech metra a dalších definovaných objektech a prostorách DPP

Obsah Změny:

Při realizaci projektu rádiové sítě TETRA pro zajištění pokrytí radiové signalizace ve všech depech metra a dalších definovaných objektech a prostorách DPP se uskutečnila řada jednání, testování a zkoušení. Na základě toho vznikly nové požadavky, které jsou detailněji popsány v příložených výkazech:

1. na všech lokalitách bude přidán 1ks bleskojistky pro svod antény GPS
2. na všech lokalitách bude upraveno silové napájení podle schválené realizační PD
3. klimatizační zařízení bude dodáno podle potřeby dle schválené realizační dokumentace
4. na některých lokalitách bude dle schválené PD potřeba stavebně oddělit technologii TETRA
5. v OZM Hostivař bude dodán a nainstalován další rack, včetně UPS, routeru a switche

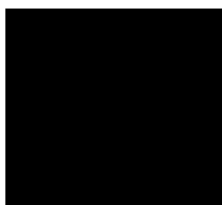
6. v budově generálního ředitelství bude zařízení rozšířeno o komponenty nutné k vnitřnímu pokrytí budovy signálem TETRA
7. v garážích Řepy a Klíčov se nebudou dodávat nové anténní svody ani nové ocelové konstrukce, budou použity stávající
8. bude dodáno 140 ks ručních radiostanic MTP3550 namísto požadovaných 250 ks. Dále bude dodáno 30 ks ručních radiostanic ST7500
9. bude dodána programovací stanice radiostanic
10. bude dodáno nahrávací zařízení MOTOROLA NICE a UPS, nebude dodána 1 operátorská konzole

Výše popsané Změny byly v souladu se Smlouvou Zhotovitelem i Objednatelem oboustranně schváleny.

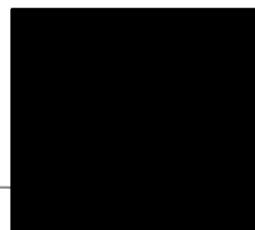
