

## Amendment No. 2 to the Standard License Agreement signed on March 15, 2018

### 1. INTRODUCTORY PROVISIONS

- 1.1. On March 15, 2018, the Contracting Parties entered into the Standard License Agreement which defines the conditions of cooperation and the rights and duties of the Contracting Parties for use of the Licensed Materials set forth in Appendix A (Business Terms) by the Licensee and Participating Institutions listed in Appendix B (Participating Institutions) (hereinafter referred to as the “Agreement”). The Agreement was published in the Register of Contracts on May 20, 2019 with the contract ID number 8415615; the Agreement was subsequently amended by Addendum No. 1, concluded on July 9, 2019.
- 1.2. The Contracting Parties desire to enter into this Amendment pursuant to Section XXII of the Agreement in order to modify the Fee and the number of APC’s for the period 2021-2022. This modification also includes a Fee reduction to commensurate the transition of the Institution of Engineering and Technology’s (IET) subscription journals to a fully open access model in 2021.



## 2. SUBJECT-MATTER OF THE AMENDMENT

2.1. The Contracting Parties have agreed that effective on January 1, 2021, Appendix A: Business Terms to the Agreement, section Licensed Materials shall be modified and replaced with the following:

### *Licensed Materials:*

- Name: IEEE/ Electronic Library (IEL)
- Number of titles: More than 1 million articles from 195 IEEE journals, magazines, and transactions.
- Over 3.6 million conference papers from as far back as 1936, with up to 200,000 added each year; 4,600+ approved and published IEEE standards; more than 12,900 papers from 20+ VDE conference titles; access to seminal articles from *Bell Labs Technical Journal* archive; and access to articles from IET's *E&T Magazine* as well as proceedings from IET conferences and events.
- Dates covered: 25 full years of IEEE journals, conference proceedings and standards (back to 1988), plus selected contents backfiles available back to 1880 with active subscription.
- Description: Access is provided via user-friendly interface IEEE Xplore, with robust search tools. IEL contains one-third of the world's current literature in electrical engineering, communications, and computer science. IEL provides access to technology's most trusted journals, conference proceedings, and standards. Provides unlimited access to more than 5 million full-text documents, in PDF format, plus HTML format where available and approximately 20,000 new IEEE documents are added each month.

2.2. The Contracting Parties have agreed that Appendix A: Business Terms to the Agreement section Fees and Negotiated Discounts subsection "Options" shall be modified and replaced with the following:

### Options:

- 2021 (group of 12): IEL \$792,900 + 5 OA APC \$8,755 = **\$801,655**
- 2022 (group of 12): IEL \$816,690 + 5 OA APC \$8,755 = **\$825,445**

## 3. FINAL PROVISIONS

3.1. The Amendment shall become valid on the date of signature by both Contracting Parties. The Amendment comes into effect on the date of its publication in the Register of Contracts under the conditions stipulated by Act No. 340/2015 Coll., On the Register of Contracts, as amended. The Amendment will be published by Licensee in the Register of Contracts.



- 3.2. All other provisions of the Agreement shall remain unaffected.
- 3.3. The Amendment is compiled in three counterparts in the English language, each of which has the power of an original. Licensor shall receive one counterpart and Licensee shall receive two counterparts.
- 3.4. The Contracting Parties agree that electronically signed versions of this originally executed Amendment are acceptable in lieu of printed signed copies and are to be given full force and effect under law and each Contracting Party declares that the electronic execution is valid and effective in the jurisdiction the Contracting Party executes the Amendment.
