PacBio de novo Assembly + Proximity Ligation + RNA Seq Library + HiRise Scaffolding + Basic Annotation Project

Scope of Work

DNA

If a tissue, blood, or cell culture Sample is provided, Dovetail will extract HMW DNA (average fragment size ~50-100kb) from a portion of the Sample, as appropriate for the Sample type. The DNA will then be checked for quality (QC'd) as described below.

If a DNA Sample is provided, Dovetail will QC the Sample by measuring the concentration, 260/280 & 260/230 ratios, and average fragment size using pulsed-field gel electrophoresis (PFGE). If the DNA passes QC, Dovetail will proceed with the library prep.

Proximity Ligation Library Preparation

Dovetail will construct one Omni-C library per 3 gigabases of the organism's genome, using the provided tissue, blood, or cell culture sample.

Dovetail will sequence ~2M PE75bp reads and map the data back to the draft assembly to assess library quality.

RNA Sequencing Library Preparation

RNA will be extracted and a standard RNA library will be prepared with rRNA-depletion. 2x150bp reads will be sequenced on an Illumina platform, and raw data from ~20M read pairs per sample will be delivered.

PacBio Library Preparation

Based on the organism's genome size and the level of PacBio sequence coverage being collected, the HMW DNA will be used to construct CLR libraries, using Blue Pippin Size selection with up to a 20Kb cutoff.

PacBio Sequencing

Sequencing of the PacBio CLR libraries will be performed on the PacBio Sequel II in an effort to collect >50Gb of raw data per 8M SMRT cell. We recommend collecting a minimum of 50X coverage for de novo assembly.

PacBio de novo Assembly

Dovetail will aim to generate 50-100X raw data coverage and assemble to generate a *de novo* assembly.

Assembly Informatics Package

Dovetail will scaffold the draft assembly (minimum N50 of 100kb is required) through our HiRise software pipeline using the proximity ligation data.

If applicable, and depending upon the metrics and complexity of the genome and HiRise output, Dovetail will perform a TAD analysis on the genome, generated from Dovetail proximity ligation libraries. The following are the input constraints for TAD analysis:

- 40% of read pairs should map at a distance > 1Kbp
- Genome size < 10Gb
- Assembly scaffold size < 400Mbp
- >40% of genome uniquely mappable
- Coverage: 100 M read pairs per 1Gb

Gene Annotation

Whole genome annotation of a genome assembly using RNA-seq data. Assembly must have >70% BUSCO single copy or duplicated score. The Basic service includes the following:

- Repeat masking
- ab initio gene prediction using related species
- RNAseq mapping to enhance annotation
- Manual curation of 5 genes
- Assignment of functional tags to genes

Deliverables

Dovetail will deliver the results files to the Customer electronically via secure FTP. The Results shall consist of:

- HiRise Assembly deliverables include:
 - The HiRise assembly in FASTA format
 - A report summarizing key assembly statistics, features of the proximity ligation library, and a linkage density plot of the proximity ligation library data
 - A table detailing the breaks made to the input scaffolds
 - A table describing the position of the input assembly scaffolds within the final HiRise scaffolds
 - BAM file(s) containing alignments of the proximity ligation library read pairs mapped to the draft assembly
- TAD Analysis deliverables, if applicable, include:
 - TAD calls at 10kbp, 25kbp, and 50kbp
 - CTCF binding sites
 - A/B compartmental organization
 - Isochore locations
 - Guide to loading and viewing data in HiGlass
 - Summary report
- RNA Sequencing Library deliverables includes six (6) FASTQ files, each containing ~20M read pairs.
- Genome Annotation deliverables consists of a comprehensive report including:
 - Genome annotation file in GFF3 format
 - Predicted gene CDS sequences in FASTA format
 - Predicted gene peptide sequences in FASTA format
 - Alignment files from RNA-seq and Iso-Seq data in BAM format (if evidence data is provided)
 - Repeat annotation file in GFF3 format
 - Visualization of structures of manually curated genes

The PacBio assembly outputs in FASTA format, including:

- A report summarizing key data and assembly statistics
- PacBio reads in fastg format

Target Timeline/Milestones

At typical project loads, the total run time for this project will be approximately 28 weeks from the receipt of draft assembly, sample, and raw read data when required. This assumes sequencing (when required) will be facilitated by Dovetail.
