By this letter, the Administration of BINP SB RAS informs and confirms the following restrictive measures of the government of the Russian Federation and the administration of the Novosibirsk region related to the COVID-19 coronavirus pandemic, which led to an increase in the duration of the Institute's work under contractual obligations.

The administration confirms that in accordance with the resolutions of the President, the government of the Russian Federation and the Novosibirsk region:

-from 28 March to present, according to the decrees of the Governor of the Novosibirsk region N243 dated 27.03.2020, No. 88 of 28.05.2020, all persons in the region aged over 65 years sh:)uld follow a policy of isolation from a residential area.

This category includes a large number, namely 590 people, the most experienced and qual!iied employees of the Institute.

Currently, in accordance with the resolutions of the Governor, restrictions on the activities of enterprises in the Novosibirsk region remain.

In accordance with paragraph 13 of the resolution of the Government of the Novosibirsk region from 18.03.2020 NQ 72-p "On introduction of high alert in the territory of the Novosibirsk region" the spread of novel coronavirus infection (COVID-19) is in the circumstances of extraordinary and unforeseen circumstance that resulted in the introduction of high alert mode in accordance with the Federal law of 21.12.1994 NQ 68-FZ "On protection of population and territories from emergency situations of natural and technogenic character", which is a force majeure event.
