I. Subject-matter of the Amendment

Article III., paragraph 3.1. is amended to extend the term of the Loan for Use until 31 March 2022.

II. Final Provisions

Amendment No. 5 shall form an integral part of the Loan Contract of 26 June 2020, ref. 230972/2019-OSM, as amended by Amendment No. 1 of 31 March 2021, ref. 225603/2021-OSM, Amendment No. 2 of 20 May 2021, ref. 226407/2021-OSM, Amendment No. 3 of 31 August 2021, ref. 227490/2021-OSM and Amendment No. 4 of 12 October 2021, ref. 228756/2021-OSM.

The remaining provisions of the Contract remain unchanged and in force.

Amendment No. 5 shall enter into force on the date of signature by both Parties and shall become effective on the date of its publication in the register of public contracts. The Lender undertakes to publish this Amendment No. 5 according to the first sentence and immediately after its signature.



The Parties declare that they have read this Amendment No. 5 and accepted its content, and they affix their signatures in witness of their free, true and serious will.

Amendment No. 5 is drawn up in two copies in Czech and two copies in English language, each having the value of an original, of which each Party shall receive one copy in Czech and one in English language. In case of conflict between the provisions, the English version shall prevail.
