## RE: Grant Agreement between Institute of Philosophy of the Czech Academy of Sciences (Grantee) and the InterAcademy Partnership

Dear (Proposal Lead):

This letter sets out the terms of our Grant Agreement under which you (the "Grantee") will provide Activities for the InterAcademy Partnership, a Washington, D.C. incorporation exempt from taxation under section 501(c)(3) of the U.S. Internal Revenue Code ("IAP") to advance the project *Combatting Predatory Academic Journals and Conferences*. The funding for this Agreement has been provided to IAP by the Moore Foundation.

- 1. <u>Activities</u>: The Agreement covers Activities that the Grantee will provide to IAP as set out in the Statement of Work (Attachment A). The Grantee will work under the direction of the IAP Project Director and the IAP-Policy Executive Director.
- 2. <u>Term</u>: The Grantee will implement Activities for IAP during the period from January 1, 2022 through the final deliverable completion date, expected by April 15, 2022. The grant cannot be extended.
- 3. <u>Payment</u>: IAP agrees to pay the Grantee up to a total of \$8,890 USD at a per deliverable rate as described below (Note: Deliverables are described in detail in Attachment A). The Grantee will submit one invoice to the IAP-Policy Executive Director following the satisfactory completion of each of the two deliverables, with Net 30 days due payment terms, specifying the completed deliverable. The Grantee may choose the currency of payment.
  - Deliverable 1: Report from Stakeholder Roundtables

  - Deliverable 2: Document on teaching module, publicity plan, and final report \$3890 To be paid upon submission and acceptance of the document on the teaching module, publicity plan, and final report
- <u>Governing Law</u>: This Agreement and the rights and obligations of the parties shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of the United States and the District of Columbia without regard to conflicts of laws.

This agreement is subject to the mutual satisfaction of IAP and the Grantee.

## **ATTACHMENT A: DELIVERABLES**

In order to advance the IAP project *Combatting Predatory Academic Journals and Conferences*, the Grantee will produce deliverables for payment based on the following:

## Deliverable 1: Stakeholder roundtable discussions summary report (in English).

- **Details:** The report will be based on the stakeholder roundtable discussions, summarizing the most essential information about the scientific community's needs for raising awareness of predatory activities. This report will serve as a basis for developing a teaching module, and it will also be published on the project website.
- **Timeline:** The stakeholder roundtable discussions will occur by the end of January 2022 with the final report completed and submitted to IAP in the early-mid February 2022 in English.
- Payment for Activities: \$5,000

## <u>Deliverable 2:</u> Summary document on training module (in English), corresponding publicity plan for both the module and report, and final report.

- **Details:** A ready-to-go teaching module will be created in the Czech language based on the information received from the stakeholder roundtable discussions. A publicity plan will also be devised to advertise the teaching module and report from the stakeholder discussions. A final reporting framework will be provided to the Grantee by IAP by the end of March 2021.
- **Timeline:** The teaching module will be designed and produced by March 2022. The Grantee will produce a document in English summarizing the main aspects of the training module for IAP before the completion of it. This document alongside the publicity plan should be submitted to IAP by early March 2022. The final report should be completed and sent to IAP by April 15, 2022.
- Payment for Activities: \$3,890
