In article 1.4.4. shall be replaced a word "work" to word "workskope" and also in this article shall be added "and the Airbus Maintenance Planning Data manhours" as follow:					
1.4.4 For each Heavy Maintenance Visit workscope that has to be performed during the subject Heavy Maintenance Visit. Parties shall discuss the differences with respect to the Routine Work and mutually agree on the manhour differences. The Boeing Maintenance Planning Data manhours and the Maintenance Planning Data manhours shall form the basis for the discussion.

In article 3.2.3. shall be deleted a part of sentence ", Aircraft exterior dry cleaning and interior deep cleaning of cockpit and cabin....." and the hole sentence shall be "Aircraft towing for maintenance (as well as to and from hangar), as well as repositioning of A/C if necessary, planning manhours, hangar rental fees, (un)docking, electricity, maintenance washing, as well
