The laws of Czech Republic shall govern this contract.

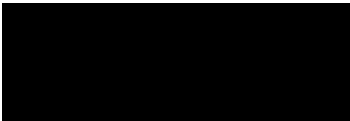

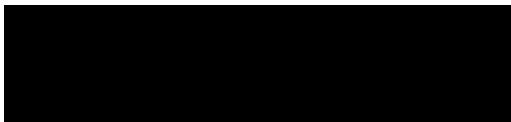

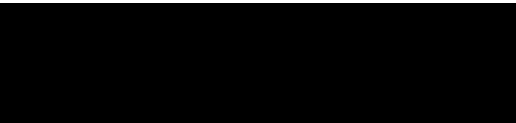
