WORK PLAN:

The submitted offer, focused on an elaboration of analysis and recommendations in the sector of public administration in terms of the Office of the Prime Minister of the Republic of Moldova, hereinafter referred to as "the Offer", consists of two parts. The first part will be based on the analysis of available facts and expert consultations during an expert mission to Moldova and conceptual materials, which are publicly available or will be made available in accordance with the purposes of the expert mission. The second part of the Offer will be the recommendation for further progress. Both parts will aim to evaluate the work of the Office of the Prime Minister of the Republic of Moldova from an institutional and functional perspective. Proposed recommendations will focus on higher efficiency of the Office's work, using experience from the Czech environment, especially with transformation and public administration reform. The Offer includes the realisation of the Demand according to the following workflow, which is structured in several key activities (KA):

a) KA 1: Desk research

During the realisation of desk research, the scope of activities of the Office of the Prime Minister of Moldova will be analysed by the team of experts. A desktop survey will be based on available information and conceptional documents at the national level in the field public of administration in Moldova until 2020 - e.g. "Institutional and Functional Analysis of the State Chancellery and the Prime-Minister Office of the Republic of Moldova", "Public Administration Reform Strategy", then "Constitution of the Republic of Moldova", "Report on the Territorial Administrative Structure Options for the Republic of Moldova", "Assessment Report of corruption risks in public procurement in the Republic of Moldova". Additionally, thematic studies and publication drafted by the OECD or EU will be scanned as well. Relevant examples of these sources are materials elaborated by SIGMA (e.g. "Strategic framework of public administration reform") or within Thematic Network Governance and public administration of European Commission ("Strategic management in the public sector"). An important part of the desk research represents also materials to be provided by the Office of the Prime Minister of the Republic of Moldova. Within this key activity, a close cooperation with Czech Development Agency is expected. In addition to expert activities, logistical arrangements related to the travel to Moldova are included (flight tickets, accommodation, local transport etc.)

b) KA 2: First expert mission

The first expert mission follows outputs from KA1. Marek Jetmar, a member of the expert team, will travel to Moldova. The mission will be focused on understanding local conditions, conducting structured interviews with local experts related to their expectations and current governmental conceptions, but it will be necessary also to take into account possible risk factors, opportunities and threats. Within this KA, a 3-days mission to Moldova is scheduled, which will be used for the above-mentioned interviews and other consultations about towards the analysis. After returning back to the Czech Republic, a mission report will be drafted by the expert to summarise information obtained during structured interviews with the representatives of the Office and other relevant stakeholders.

c) KA 3: Drafting of a structure and content of the analysis and recommendations

Activity KA 3 will focus on drafting of a structure and content of the analysis and recommendations. It will be in line with previous two KAs. A draft version of the structure will be prepared in English. It will aim at the practical usage of documents and experience from the Czech Republic, eventually from other countries. The draft of the document structure will contain particular cross-cutting examples of good practice in the Czech Republic. Within KA3, consultations about the draft version of the structure with the Czech Development Agency will be scheduled. After incorporating all remarks and comments, the expert team will proceed to KA4.

d) KA 4: Elaboration of analysis and recommendations

After the approval of a structure for the final output by the Czech Development Agency within KA4, the expert team will prepare the final document, which will meet all requirements of the Czech Development Agency (e.g. at least 30 pages). The document will focus on improvement of the effectiveness of the Office of the Prime Minister of the Republic



of Moldova and will identify two groups of measures – strategic and operational. The analysis will be structured into several thematic areas (human resources, processes, competency model etc.) and will emphasise a practical usage and applicability in terms of Moldova and its relation to the EU – e.g. allocation of financial resources within European Neighbourhood Instrument for public administration reform in Moldova.

During the elaboration of the analysis, the expert team will take into account Czech experience with public administration processes. It can help to identify potential risks and threats. Concurrently, the expert team will consult the working version of the document with Czech Development Agency and will incorporate all comments.

e) KA 5: Second expert mission

The second expert mission will focus on the presentation of the main output. Finding a wide audience can be considered as one of the main preconditions of a successful presentation, enabling highest possible overall result. Therefore, preparation of KA5 will be coordinated in close cooperation with the Czech Development Agency to reach adequate cooperation with the representatives of the Office. A Powerpoint presentation will be prepared for purposes of summarization of main conclusions.
