## **Bilateral Inter-Institutional Agreement**

Key Action 1
Learning Mobility for Higher Education Students and Staff

among EU Member States and third countries associated to the Programme

The institutions agree to cooperate for the exchange of students and/or staff in the context of the Erasmus+ programme. They commit to respect the quality requirements of the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education in all aspects related to the organisation and management of the mobility, including automatic recognition of the credits awarded to students by the partner institution as agreed in the Learning Agreement and confirmed in the Transcript of Records, or according to the learning outcomes of the modules completed abroad, as described in the Course Catalogue, in line with the European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System. The institutions agree on exchanging their mobility related data in line with the technical standards of the European Student Card Initiative.

#### **Grading systems of the institutions**

• Students must be nominated through Palacký University on-line system. The institutional coordinator and the person responsible for student mobilities at the sending institution will receive information about the nomination procedure and access to the system at least three months before the deadline.

- Incoming students are allowed to take courses in other study fields but they are requested to take the majority of courses in the study area mentioned in this agreement.
- The partner university is kindly requested to ensure that the language proficiency of the outgoing student(s) is a minimum B2.
- Students are offered a Czech language course throughout the semester.
- Academic staff interested in a teaching visit at UP should contact the relevant department.
- Non-academic staff members interested in spending a training week at UP should contact the International Office . A proposal of the Mobility Agreement is also required.
- \*PhD short-term mobilities for study / research (5 30 days), or a traineeship (5 30 days), are as a new E+ activity listed on a separate line.

### **Termination of the agreement**

In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
