The remaining 50% instalment will be paid after the event and upon presentation and approval of the Initial Assessment Report and the Final Report (together with the detailed budget table). The reports and forms requested will be filled-in and sent to NATO Public Diplomacy Division, in accordance to the guidelines attached.
