V ceně jsou zahrnuty veškeré nezbytné náklady k řádné a úplné realizaci díla dle čl. Smluvní strany si dodatek č. 1 přečetly, s jeho obsahem souhlasí, což stvrzují svými podpisy.

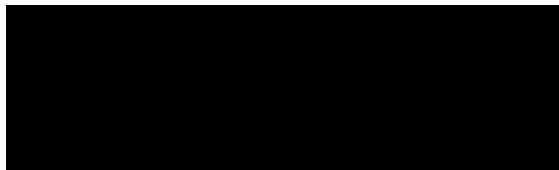
