**AGREEMENT OF ACADEMIC COOPERATION
Between
CHUNGNAM NATIONAL UNIVERSITY
And
CHARLES UNIVERSITY**

In recognition of their common interests in developing bilateral relations and convinced that cooperation between institutes of higher learning contributes to cultural enrichment, scientific progress, and the consolidation of friendship between countries, Chungnam National University (hereinafter “CNU”), Daejeon, Republic of Korea, and Charles University (hereinafter “CU”), Prague, Czech Republic, agree to establish the following Agreement of Academic Cooperation.

I

This agreement will promote activities in the following areas:

- Exchange of students
- Exchange of faculty and administrative staff
- Collaborative research projects, lectures, symposia, seminars, workshops, etc.
- Exchange of academic credits, information, and materials
- Collaboration in instructional and cultural programs, including publication activities of mutual interests and shared access to information networks
- Collaboration in reciprocal culture and education.

II

Specific mechanisms for the implementation of particular cooperative and collaborative activities shall be established and described in writing by the responsible authority of each institution prior to the initiation of any particular program or activity.

The parties agree that the specific cooperation, activities and exchanges of participants between the parties will follow up on this general document by entering into special contracts, which will regulate the protection of personal data, the insurance of the participants, the possibility of withdrawal, the choice of applicable law and, where appropriate, the publication of the contract in the Czech register of contracts, in addition to the specific conditions.

III

1. All activities developed under the auspices of this Agreement will comply with the procedures, policies, and practices of each institution as well as the law and regulations of the host country.

2. Both institutions acknowledge that the visit by faculty and students from one institution to the other shall be subject to the entry and visa regulations of each country and shall comply with the regulations and policies of CNU and CU.

IV

1. This Agreement is established for a period of five years, effective on the date of its signing.

2. In order to enhance the efficacy of their cooperative activities, CNU and CU agree that it shall be possible to introduce changes and additions to the Agreement by means of mutually agreed upon additional written clauses.

3. At the end of each five-year period, this Agreement will be automatically renewed by mutual agreement for an additional five years, unless CNU or CU provides written notification of a decision of non-renewal prior to the expiration date. A minimum period of six months notice will be required from either party wishing to terminate the Agreement. In the event of termination, all commitment to students participating in the program will be honored by relevant parties.

**AGREEMENT OF ACADEMIC COOPERATION

A minimum period of six months' notice will be required from either party wishing to terminate the Agreement. In the event of termination, all commitment to students participating in the program will be honored by relevant parties.
