



AGREEMENT

Between

The Service de Cooperation et d'Action Culturelle of the French Embassy in Prague and the French Institute in Prague, Stepanska 644/35, 110 00 Praha 1-Nove Mesto, represented by

and

Czech Technical University in Prague, Faculty of Mechanical Engineering, Technicka 4, 160 00 Praha 6, represented by

*hereinafter referred to as the «Partners»,
have agreed as follows.*

Article 1 - Purpose of the agreement

The French Institute in Prague (IFP) and the Czech Technical University in Prague, Faculty of Mechanical Engineering commit themselves to financially supporting French courses for a maximum of 7 students enrolled at Czech Technical University in Prague, Faculty of Mechanical Engineering Prague at the rate of one course term per student per academic year.

Eligible students are students enrolled at Czech Technical University in Prague, Faculty of Mechanical Engineering in the Master of Automotive Engineering who will be performing a mobility to France (study or internship).

Article 2 - French courses

The selected students will benefit from French courses offered at IFP. The French courses which will be offered to Czech Technical University in Prague, Faculty of Mechanical Engineering students will be determined jointly by the Partners.

Article 3 - Registration to the courses

The registration of students to the selected courses will be based on an official list of nominated students issued by Czech Technical University in Prague, Faculty of Mechanical Engineering and sent to IFP prior to the beginning of each course registration period. The IFP will confirm



registration Czech Technical University in Prague, Faculty of Mechanical Engineering students to the course by sending a list of names to within two weeks after the course has started.

Article 4 - Payment of the course fees

The course fees for the French courses organized by the French Institute in Prague will be covered 50% by the Service de Cooperation et d'Action Culturelle of the French Embassy in Prague, and 50% by the students themselves for Czech students, or by the Czech Technical University in Prague, Faculty of Mechanical Engineering, for non-Czech students.

IFP will offer the in-situ group courses with a total time allocation of 30 hours. The price of the course will correspond to actual pricelist published before the schoolyear on www.ifp.cz.

The invoice for the payment for the selected students will be accompanied by copies of Certificates of successful course completion issued for individual students by the IFP. Besides, the attendance sheet from the individual courses will be enclosed to the invoice.

The invoices will be issued on a semester basis.

Article 5 - Administration contacts for the cooperation

Article 6 - Validity of the agreement

The agreement is valid for a period of two years, as of October 1st 2024.

This agreement may be renewed with the consent of the Partners or terminated at the initiative of any Partner with a written notice sent to the partner institution 3 months prior to the expiry date of this agreement in the form of an Amendment.

Any termination must take into consideration the right of students already participating or accepted in the course to complete it.



Each Partner is entitled to withdraw from the agreement in case that the opposite Partner commits a breach of the duty to which this agreement bounds it, or even terminate it for convenience. The Partner which has committed a breach of the contractual duty is obliged to make good the damage to the opposite Partner including appropriately expended costs incurred to the opposite Partner in the consequence of the withdrawal of this convention. If this convention is terminated for convenience, the duty belongs to the terminating Partner. The termination of the convention is effective as of a written notice about termination of the convention is delivered to the opposite Partner.

This convention might be amended at any time by the exchange of letters between the two Partners. Such amendments, once approved by both institutions, will become part of this convention. The amendments cannot be applied to the already enrolled students unless they are favorable to them.

The Partners acknowledge that for its effectiveness this contract requires the publication in the registry of contracts pursuant to the Act No. 340/2015 Coll., and they agree with this publication. This convention has been signed in two originals in English. Each Partner will receive one original.
