

**PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT**

on the other part,

together referred to as "the Parties"

have agreed to implement the project "**International Collaborative Learning in OSH**" under the Erasmus+ Programme, Key Action 2: Strategic Partnerships, hereinafter referred to as "the Project" as follows:

Article 1 - Subject matter

1. This Partnership Agreement shall regulate relations between the parties, and their respective rights and obligations with regard to their participation in the project **International Collaborative Learning in OSH (COLOSH)** under the Grant Agreement **2024-1-CZ01-KA220-HED-000257634** concluded between the **National Agency** and the **Coordinator**.
2. The **total grant of the project** for the contractual period referred to by the Grant Agreement 2024-1-CZ01-KA220-HED-000257634, is estimated at 400 000 EUR and shall take the form of lump sum grant contributions and reimbursement of eligible costs.



3. The subject matter of the Partnership Agreement and the related work packages and activities are detailed in the annexes, which form an integral part of this agreement and that each party declares to have read and approved.
4. With the signature of this Partnership Agreement, the **Coordinator** and the **Partners** accept the grant and agree to implement the Project, acting on their own responsibility.

Article 2 - Duration

1. The duration of the Project is 30 months. It starts on 01/11/2024 and ends on 30/04/2027.
2. This Partnership Agreement enters into force on the date of signature by the last of both parties to the agreement and terminates five years after the date of payment of the balance by the Coordinator to the Partner.
3. The period of eligibility of the costs starts on 01/11/2024 and finishes on 30/04/2027.

Article 3 - Obligations of the Coordinator

The Coordinator shall undertake:

1. to take all the steps necessary to prepare for, perform and correctly manage the Project in accordance with the objectives of the Project as set out in the Grant Agreement concluded between the National Agency and the Coordinator;
2. to share with the Partner a copy of the Grant Agreement **2024-1-CZ01-KA220-HED-000257634** and its annexes concluded with the National Agency, and various reports and any other official documents concerning the project;
3. to notify and provide the Partner with any amendment made to the Grant Agreement **2024-1-CZ01-KA220-HED-000257634** concluded with the National Agency;
4. to define in conjunction with the Partner the role and rights and obligations of the parties, including those concerning the attribution of the intellectual property rights;
5. to comply with all the provisions of Grant Agreement **2024-1-CZ01-KA220-HED-000257634** binding the **Coordinator** to the **National Agency**.

Article 4 - Obligations of the Partner

The Partner shall undertake:

1. to take all the steps necessary to prepare for, perform and correctly manage the Project in accordance with the objectives of the project as set out in the Grant Agreement **2024-1-CZ01-KA220-HED-000257634** concluded between the **National Agency** and the **Coordinator**;

An outline of the tasks that the Partner is in charge of could be found in Annex II.



2. to communicate to the Coordinator any information or documents required by the latter that is necessary for the management of the project;
3. to accept responsibility for all information communicated to the Coordinator, including details of costs claimed and, where appropriate, ineligible expenses;
4. to define in conjunction with the Coordinator the role and rights and obligations of the parties, including those concerning the attribution of the intellectual property rights.

Article 5 - Financing

1. The maximum grant of the Partner for the period covered by the Partnership Agreement is estimated at 40.000,00 EUR. The partner's detailed budget is described in the Annex I of this Partnership Agreement.

Article 6 – Budget transfers

1. The Coordinator commits itself to carrying out payments relating to the subject matter of this agreement to the Partner according to the achievement of the tasks and according to the following schedule:

The Coordinator reserves the right to withhold this Additional prefinancing if the partner's report to Coordinator is submitted after the deadline mentioned in article 8 of this agreement.
Balance payment	20% of the budget allocated to the <i>Partner</i>	Within 60 calendar days of receiving the final payment from the National Agency The balance will be paid once the Partner's contractual obligations have been fully met, all the necessary supporting documentation has been received and the National Agency has approved the final report. The Coordinator reserves the right



		to withhold the balance payment and demand a refund of the amounts already paid if the report is presented after the deadline mentioned in article 8 of this agreement.
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2. All payments shall be regarded as advances pending explicit approval of the final report, the corresponding cost statement and the quality of the results of the project by the National Agency.

Article 8 - Reporting

1. The Partner shall provide the Coordinator with any information and document required for the preparation of the Periodic report and, where appropriate, with copies of all the necessary supporting documents *completed and signed by the legal representative or financial representative* by **28.2.2026** at the latest.
2. The Partner shall provide the Coordinator with any information and document required for the preparation of the Progress report and, where appropriate, with copies of all the necessary supporting documents *completed and signed by the legal representative or financial representative* by **31.10.2026** at the latest.
3. The Partner shall provide the Coordinator with any information and document required for the preparation of the Final report and, where appropriate, with copies of all the necessary supporting documents *completed and signed by the legal representative or financial representative* by **31.05.2027** at the latest.
4. The required information and documentation within the Project shall be provided in English.

Article 9- Monitoring and supervision

1. The Partner shall provide without delay the Coordinator with any information that the latter may request from him concerning the carrying out of the Project covered by this agreement.
2. The Partner shall make available to the Coordinator any documents making it possible to check that the afore mentioned Project is being or has been carried out.



Article 10 - Liability

1. The Coordinator and Partner are jointly responsible for the *technical* implementation of the action. If one of the beneficiaries fails to implement their part of the action, the other beneficiaries must ensure that this part is implemented by someone else (without being entitled to an increase of the maximum grant amount and subject to an amendment; see Article 7 of the Grant Agreement **2024-1-CZ01-KA220-HED-000257634**). The *financial* responsibility of each beneficiary in case of recoveries is governed by Article 22 of the Grant Agreement **2024-1-CZ01-KA220-HED-000257634**.
2. Each contracting party shall release the other from any civil liability in respect of damages resulting from the performance of this agreement, suffered by itself or by its personnel, to the extent that these damages are not due to the serious or intentional negligence of the other party or its personnel.
3. The Partner shall protect the National Agency, the Coordinator and their personnel against any action for damages suffered by third parties, including project personnel, as a result of the performance of this agreement, to the extent that these damages are not due to the serious or intentional negligence of the National Agency, the Beneficiary or their personnel.

Article 11 - Termination of the agreement

1. The Coordinator may terminate the Partnership Agreement if the Partner has inadequately discharged or failed to discharge any of the contractual obligations, insofar as this is not due to *force majeure*, after notification of the Partner by registered letter has remained without effect for one month.
2. The Partner shall immediately notify the Coordinator, supplying all relevant information, of any event likely to prejudice the performance of this agreement.

Article 12 - Jurisdiction clause

12.1 The law applicable to this agreement shall be the law of **the Czech Republic**.

12.2 Failing amicable settlement, the Courts of **the Czech Republic** shall have sole competence to rule on any dispute between the contracting parties in respect of this agreement.

Article 13 - Amendments or additions to the agreement

Amendments to this agreement shall be made only by a supplementary Agreement signed on behalf of each of the parties by the signatories to this agreement.
