The agreement concerns the organisation of an Adult Learners Mobility in which 10 participants and 2 accompanying persons from the Sending Organisation will take part. The mobility will take place from 02.06.2025 to 06.06.2025 in Jelenia Góra, Poland.

The Host Organisation undertakes to organise and conduct workshops and joint activities for a group of Czechian adult learners, in the field of environmental protection.

Description of activities and learning outcomes

All training will be conducted in accordance with the Experiential Learning Cycle method.

ACTIVITY 1: Workshop "How human activity changes the earth"

Working in pairs/groups, guided discussion, creating infographics. Participants will use laptops and smartphones.

Participants will develop skills of cooperation and group communication, and establish cross-cultural ties, their knowledge of the impact of human activities on the environment will increase, will learn how to search for information online effectively and how to use a digital translator.

ACTIVITY 2: Workshop of Czech and Polish seniors on the topic of Reduce Reuse Recycling

Discussion, show & tell, poster-making, pair/group work.

Participants will understand the principles of "Reduce, Reuse, Recycle" and their impact on the environment, recognize the environmental consequences of excessive clothing consumption

ACTIVITY 3: Workshops: Renewable energy sources on the Bóbr trail. Sustainable energy management at home.

Mini-lecture, guided discussion, demonstration, pair/group work

Participants will understand the basic concepts related to renewable energy sources (RES) and identify simple ways to save energy at home.

ACTIVITY 4: Visit to Książ Castle and Palm House as an opportunity to increase digital skills of seniors.

Individual and pair work, using smartphone in various tasks.

Participants will be able to take and organize quality photos using their smartphone's camera and gallery tools. Includes using camera settings, framing photos, creating albums or folders, and deleting or sharing selected pictures.

Participants will be able to use smartphone features to find and understand historical or botanical information.

– Includes scanning QR codes, using translation apps, or searching online for facts about Książ Castle and plants in the Palm House.

ACTIVITY 5: Workshop Water access and responsible water use.

Mini-lecture & discussion, group brainstorming

Participants will understand global water access issues and the importance of responsible water use, recognize the impact of daily water consumption on the environment, learn simple, practical ways to reduce water waste at home.

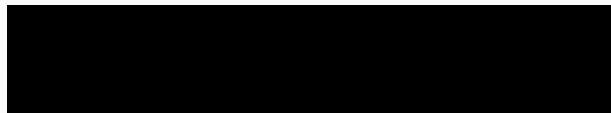
The workshops will include meals, organization and implementation of workshops, local travel and entry fees for 10 seniors and 2 accompanying persons.
