(the "Buyer" and the "Seller" hereinafter collectively referred to as the "**Parties**" or "**Contracting Parties**")



## I.

In accordance with the clause XIV subclause 1 of the Framework agreement for the production and supply of the paper for passport visa pages (No. 022/OS/2022) concluded on December 14, 2022, in the version amended by the Amendment no. 1 concluded on January 29, 2025 (hereinafter this version referred to as the „Framework Agreement”) and in accordance with Article XIV paragraph 1 of the Framework Agreement, the Parties have agreed upon the following changes to the Framework Agreement:

1. The Annex No. 1 of the Framework Agreement is replaced by the Annex No. 1 to this Amendment No. 2. The yellow marked parts in the Section XXX and XXX of this new Annex No. 1 (i.e. Annex No. 1 to this Amendment No. 2) will be agreed in writing by both Contracting parties after the conclusion of this Amendment in the form of a protocol, which will be signed by at least one representative authorized to negotiate in factual and technical matters for each Contracting party.
2. Article II paragraph 3 point b. of the Framework Agreement is replaced by the following:

“b. the separate part which contains classified information in secrecy level "RESTRICTED" (“VYHRAZENÉ”) and which is an integral part of the overall Technical specification. This classified part of Technical specification is established and registered with the Buyer under No. XXX pursuant to Act No. 412/2005 Coll., on protection of classified information and security eligibility, as amended.”
3. Article III paragraph 2 of the Framework Agreement is replaced by the following:

„2. The order shall be sent to the Seller electronically to the Seller's e-mail address [XXX](#) and copy to the back office [XXX](#).”
4. In Art. II of the Framework Agreement the new paragraph 8 is inserted after the paragraph 7:

“8. All detailed elements of the technical specification not explicitly mentioned in the technical specification pursuant to Article II paragraph 3 of this framework contract shall be agreed in writing by the contracting parties within the framework of the individual partial contract, whereby the Contracting Parties agree that these detailed elements of the technical specification shall always be respected and shall always be in accordance with the technical specification pursuant to Art. II paragraph 3 of this Framework Agreement.”
5. Article IV paragraph 10 of the Framework Agreement is replaced by the following:

„10. The Seller is not entitled to supply a larger quantity of Goods than required by the Buyer in the relevant written order; in the event of supply of a larger quantity of



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Goods, the partial contract for this surplus is not concluded unless the Buyer approves additionally the acceptance of the surplus to the e-mail address [XXX](#) and [XXX](#).”

6. Price table in article V paragraph 1 of the Framework Agreement as amended by article I paragraph 2 of the amendment No. 1, is replaced by the following:

7. Unit prices mentioned in paragraph 2 of this Article will be effective for the performance delivered on the basis of orders placed by the Buyer after taking effect of this Amendment No. 2.

8. Article VII paragraph 5 of the Framework Contract is replaced by the following:

„5. Any complaint shall be accepted or rejected within 10 (ten) calendar days from its communication to the Seller to the e-mail address: [XXX](#) and [XXX](#).”

9. Article XIII paragraphs 2 to 4 of the Framework Contract are replaced by the following:

“2. This Framework Agreement has been entered into for a definite period of time, namely:

- a. to **31<sup>st</sup> December 2026**, or
- b. until the maximum financial limit **EUR 1 400 000** will be exhausted, whichever is the earlier.



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3. The duration of this Framework Agreement under Paragraph 2 of this Article may be prolonged by 1 year and the maximum financial limit agreed in Paragraph 2 of this Article may be increased by EUR 400 000, i.e. for total time period to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2027, or until the maximum financial limit EUR 1 800 000 will be exhausted, whichever is the earlier. The Parties agreed that the duration of this Framework Agreement under the previous sentence will be prolonged if the Buyer notifies in writing form its intention to prolong this Framework Agreement in accordance with this Paragraph. The notification according to the previous sentence must be delivered to the Seller no later than 6 months before the original termination of this Framework Agreement.
4. The duration of this Framework Agreement under Paragraph 3 of this Article may be prolonged by 1 more year and the maximum financial limit under Paragraph 3 may be increased by further EUR 400 000, i.e. for total time period to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2028, or until the maximum financial limit EUR 2 200 000 will be exhausted, whichever is the earlier. The Parties agreed that the duration of this Framework Agreement under the previous sentence will be prolonged if the Buyer notifies in writing form its intention to prolong this Framework Agreement in accordance with this Paragraph. The notification according to the previous sentence must be delivered to the Seller no later than 6 months before the original termination of this Framework Agreement in accordance with the Paragraph 3 of this Article. In the event that the duration of this Framework Agreement is not prolonged in accordance with Paragraph 3 of this Article, this Paragraph 4 shall not apply.“

## II.

1. The other provisions of the Framework Agreement and the Annexes to the Framework Agreement shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
2. This Amendment No. 2 is drawn up in electronic form, with both Contracting Parties receiving its electronic original with qualified electronic signatures of the responsible person and with a qualified electronic time stamp in accordance with REGULATION (EU) No 910/2014 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 23 July 2014 on electronic identification and trust services for electronic transactions in the internal market and repealing Directive 1999/93/EC and Act No. 297/2016 Sb., on trust-creating services for electronic transactions, as amended later regulations. In the event that this Amendment No. 2 is not drawn up in electronic form for any reason, it will be drawn up and signed in two copies, with each of the Contracting Parties receiving one copy.
3. The Parties take into consideration that in accordance with Section 219 (1) (d) of the PPA, this Amendment No. 2 shall be published in the Register of Contracts pursuant to Act No. 340/2015 Coll., laying down special conditions for the effectiveness of certain contracts, the disclosure of these contracts and the register of contracts (the Register of Contracts Act), as amended. The publication shall be arranged by the Buyer.



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4. This Amendment No. 2 comes into validity on the day of signature by both Contracting Parties and into effect on day of its publication in the Register of Contracts.
