(the **"Seller"** and the **"Buyer"** hereinafter collectively referred to as the **"Parties"** or **"Contracting Parties"**)

I.

1. The Contracting Parties concluded the above-mentioned Purchase contract on 2nd December 2024 (hereinafter referred to as the **"Contract"**). The subject of the Contract is the sale of the Seller's **finishing line for the production of passports**, manufacturer Kugler-Womako GmbH, Schlosserstrasse 15, Nürtingen, D-72622, Germany, Year of manufacturing: 2000, Commissioning: 4/2002 (hereinafter the **"Machine"**).
2. The Contracting Parties have agreed in accordance with the provision of Article XI, paragraph 3 of the Contract on the following changes to the Contract in accordance with the provisions of Sec. 222 of Act No. 134/2016 Coll., on public procurement, as amended:

- a) The current wording of Article III, paragraphs 3 of the Contract is replaced by the following new wording:

“3. The Buyer acknowledges that the Machine remains in operation till the moment of the disassembly to ensure the continuous production until the replacement with a new machine. The Seller needs to prepare transport way for moving out the Machine from the installation site. The start of disassembly and moving out shall be determined based on the Seller’s notification following the completion of construction preparation of the transport ways to the installation site. The Seller’s notification referred to in the previous sentence of this paragraph must be made by email to the following addresses: XXX and XXX and the Buyer must start disassembly of the Machine within 30 calendar days of receiving the notification”.

II.

1. The other provisions of the Contract shall remain unchanged.
2. This Amendment becomes valid on the day it is signed by both Contracting Parties and takes effect once it is published in the Register of Contracts.
3. The Contracting Parties take into consideration that this Amendment shall be published in the Register of Contracts pursuant to Act No. 340/2015 Coll., laying down special conditions for the effectiveness of certain contracts, the disclosure of these contracts and the register of contracts (the Register of Contracts Act), as amended. The publication shall be arranged by the Seller.
4. This Amendment is drawn up in English in two counterparts, out of which the Buyer shall obtain one counterpart and the Seller shall obtain one counterpart.
5. The Contracting Parties declare they agree with the content hereof and this Amendment is prepared in a certain and intelligible manner, on the basis of true, free and serious will of the Contracting Parties, without any duress on either Contracting Party.
