HAVE AGREED AS FOLLOWS

Art. I – Duration and Purpose

110.1 The coordinator is responsible for implementing the following research project(s): RAY MON, RAY SOC, RAY MISS and RAY OPEN in the context of the RAY Network (Research based Analysis of European Youth Programmes) in the framework of the TCA/NET 2025 (see as reference the respective ‘concept note’ and ‘research budget’ in the internal area of the RAY website, <https://www.researchyouth.net/internal-area/>, subsection: RAY research projects 2025).

RAY MON: Research project on the research-based analysis and monitoring of Erasmus+ Youth (RAY MON). This study is implemented between July 2025 and December 2025 in the framework of the TCA.

RAY SOC: Research project on the research-based analysis and monitoring of the European Solidarity Corps (RAY SOC). This study is implemented between July 2025 and December 2025 in the framework of the NET.

RAY MISS: Research project on who is missing from the European youth programs (RAY MISS). This study is implemented between January 2025 and December 2025 in the framework of the TCA.

RAY OPEN: Project to accelerate the implementation of the new RAY open data portal (RAY OPEN). This study is implemented between January 2025 and December 2025 in the framework of the TCA/NET.

Art. 2 – Financing

- 2.1 The partner agrees to make a financial contribution to the costs related to the activities and services described in the respective concept note(s) (see I.I. above) by the following maximum amounts:

- 2.2. The calculations of the financial contributions are based on a flat fee for all partners of the respective research project (one third) plus a fee proportional to the size of the decentralised funds managed by the partner (amounts 2024). The calculation overview(s) can be found in the ANNEX.

Art. 3 – Payments

- 3.1 The partner will pay the amount specified in article 2.1 within 30 days after receiving the invoice from the coordinator.
- 3.2 The coordinator reserves the right to impose penalty fees and interest according to Interest Act as well as take further legal actions in case the payment of the amount specified in 2.1. is severely delayed.

Art. 4 – Implementation

- 4.1. The coordinator will subcontract Youth Policy Labs – Non-profit think tank for youth research to implement all related research activities (as mentioned in this agreement and in accordance with the respective concept note) and the reporting.
- 4.2. The coordinator undertakes to implement all transnational research activities in accordance with the respective concept note for the research project(s).
- 4.3. The partner undertakes to implement all national research activities in accordance with the respective concept note for the research project(s).
- 4.4. The coordinator undertakes to support all national research activities, including but not limited to the organisation of meetings of the working group established for the respective research project(s) (if applicable), the development of guidelines, and the provision of supporting material.
- 4.5. The partner undertakes to support all transnational research activities, including but not limited to case studies and/or interviews, and the realisation of translations.

- 4.6. The respective concept note(s) can be found in the internal area of the RAY website. The working group of the respective research project(s) and/or the RAY Coordination and RAY Transnational Research Team and/or the RAY Strategy Group may choose to adjust the concept note – if revised in that way it replaces the other one automatically. The partner will be informed by the coordinator of such an adjustment.

Art. 5 – Report

- 5.1. The coordinator will communicate implementation report(s) 3 months after the dates specified in article 1.1. at the latest.
- 5.2. The coordinator will communicate respective research findings/reports according to the project schedule outlined in the respective concept note. The coordinator reserves the right to delay research findings/reports due to possible adaptations of the project schedule.

Art. 6 – Data Protection

- 6.1. The partner agrees to provide it's personal data, namely "name", "address" and "bank data" for the purpose of contract performance. The data will be shared with the accounting department of the coordinator. The data will not be shared with third parties.
- 6.2. The coordinator and all partners are obliged to comply with the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation)

Art. 7 – Other provisions

- 7.1. The coordinator commits itself to undertake the project in full respect of sound financial management, non-profit and procurement rules.
- 7.2. This agreement is governed by Finnish Law. Helsinki shall be the place of court for any disputes arising from this agreement.
- 7.3. The agreement shall enter into force on the date when the last of the two parties signs. The electronic signatures are ensured through the VismaSign system.
- 7.4. Made in English language.
