Smluvní strany se dohodly, v souladu s ustanovením čl. 19 Společná ustanovení odst. 19.3., na uzavření tohoto dodatku č. 3 ke smlouvě o dílo (dále jen „smlouva“) na realizaci akce „Tábor – rekonstrukce VUZ a vybudování KCVV – realizace“ uzavřené mezi výše uvedenými smluvními stranami dne 23. 8. 2024 ve znění dodatku č. 1 ze dne 27. 9. 2024 a dodatku č. 2 ze dne 28. 4. 2025. Tímto dodatkem č. 3 se smlouva mění následovně:

1) V článku 5 Cena za dílo, platební podmínky se ruší odst. 5.1 a nahrazuje se novým zněním:

5.1. Smluvní strany se dohodly na této celkové výši ceny za dílo:

- a. Celková cena bez DPH 63 178 922,10 Kč (slovy: šedesát tři milionů sto sedmdesát osm tisíc devět set dvacet dva korun českých, deset haléřů)
- b. DPH 12 % ve výši 7 581 470,65 Kč (slovy: sedm milionů pět set osmdesát jedna tisíc čtyři sta sedmdesát korun českých, šedesát pět haléřů)
- c. Celková cena včetně DPH ve výši 70 760 392,75 Kč (slovy: sedmdesát milionů sedm set šedesát tisíc tři sta devadesát dva korun českých, sedmdesát pět haléřů,

(dále též „Cena za provedení díla“);

2) V článku 20 Závěrečná ustanovení v odstavci 20.4 se stávající znění přílohy č. 3 „Podrobný harmonogram výstavby“ ruší a nahrazuje novým aktuálním zněním. Toto nové znění je součástí tohoto dodatku a nedílnou přílohou č. 3 této smlouvy.

3) Smlouva o dílo se doplňuje o:

Přílohu č. 5: Oznámení změny a změnový list č. 8-9 vč. rozpočtu změn a fotodokumentace

Ostatní ustanovení smlouvy o dílo se dodatkem č. 3 nemění.

Dodatek č. 3 je vyhotoven v elektronické podobě v jednom vyhotovení v českém jazyce s elektronickými podpisy obou smluvních stran v souladu se zákonem č. 297/2016 Sb., o službách vytvářejících důvěru pro elektronické transakce, ve znění pozdějších předpisů.

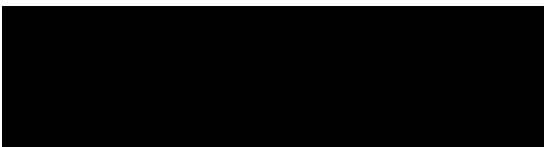
