CONTEXT AND RATIONALE		
Context: <i>Problem analysis. Please explain current situation and why the expert is requested (what is his/her added value).</i> The City of Čačak has been dealing with solid communal waste for more than a decade. The problem has been dealt to the full capacity, from building regional sanitary waste land, i.e. regional system for managing of communal waste, to the smallest details connected to development of primary selection on the territory of the city, which is in fact, the base of every serious consideration of dealing with communal waste. When Serbia is in question, Čačak has more than well developed primary selection and it covers almost 15000 households, mostly in urban area and suburban settlements. What we wish is to increase degree of primary selection on a higher level so as to have better success in selection, although we have to		



point out that, for Serbian conditions, that segment is quite good, too. We would like to get a point of view of an expert about the current state in the field of managing of communal waste and to give us suggestions for improvement of our work and business.

Expected outputs and outcomes:

Expected results of Czech expert's work are analysis of the state in the field of managing of communal solid waste and training of the employed in JKP Komunalac Čačak in the sense of increase of primary selection, city zones, charging of citizens, then selection promotion among citizens, etc. One of the concrete results that we expect is to have new projects in the course of time through which our communal company would improve its own capacities for taking away of waste – vehicle fleet is pretty old and new vehicles are needed, for primary selection first of all, as well as underground containers at more locations in the city.

Role of the applicant/partner organisation and roles of other key partners:

Apart from the employed from the City of Čačak, as a unit of local self government, the employed from JKP Komunalac Čačak will also take part in the project realization as it is a public company which is the main operator in managing of communal waste. JKP company will be the main and final beneficiary of project results and the engagement of the expert should reflect on their business and their primary functions in local community.

Complementarity:

As it has already been stated, the City of Čačak has been dealing systematically with solving problem of communal solid waste and numerous international projects have been realized which have contributed the current good state in this field in Čačak. Engagement of an expert will certainly contribute and will be complementary with all the efforts which have been done. So, with our own efforts and numerous cooperation until now we have reached more than a positive situation in the field of managing of communal waste – built regional waste land Duboko, transfer station, 15 000 households in the system of primary selection, waste is collected on the whole territory both urban and rural, many promotional materials have been made, etc. Definitely, it is always possible to make one step further and now we see that step in new cooperation and new projects which would be the outcome of communication with high quality expert.
