together hereinafter referred to as the “Contracting Parties”

have concluded the following

### contract for work – editing – part one

on the day, month and year specified below pursuant to the provisions of § 2586 et seq. and § 2631 of Act No. 89/2012 Coll., the Civil Code, as amended, (hereinafter referred to as the “Civil Code”):

### Preamble

1. The Client is currently preparing and ensuring the publication of a comprehensive work entitled Josef Ludvík Fischer – výbor z díla IV., volume of collected works of Josef Ludvík Fischer (hereinafter referred to as the “Publication”). The Publication will include independent works of authorship by Prof. PhDr. Ludvík Fischer, the first post-war rector of Palacký University in Olomouc, (hereinafter referred to as “JLF”) and other authors.
2. The purpose of this contract is to regulate the mutual rights and obligations of the contracting parties aimed at participating in the creation of the Publication as a

comprehensive work by the Contractor within the meaning of this contract, performing editorial work on the Publication. The purpose of this contract is also, in particular, the use of the Publication by the Client and the Publisher of the Publication for the purposes of preparing and ensuring the publication of the Publication.

## **I.**

### **Subject of the obligation, conditions for the performance of the work**

1. The contractor hereby undertakes to the client, in cooperation with co-editor [REDACTED], to perform the work consisting in the creative editing of the works listed in Annex of this contract entitled List of studies for editing and finalization – part one (where the texts for editing and texts for finalization are differentiated) (hereinafter the „Works“) so that the Publication is prepared for the client to hand over to the publisher for its publication; the performance of the editorial activity includes in particular the necessary proofreading and the necessary unification of the texts of the Publication, including the annotation apparatus and bibliographical data; the Contractor is obliged to ensure the execution of the editing - finalization - of all parts of the Works, including the editing of the text and the language editing, for the Publication.
2. The Contracting Parties hereby declare that the Client has handed over all the Works to the Contractor by the date of conclusion of this contract.

(all hereinafter referred to as the “Work”).

## **II.**

### **Time of execution of the Work and its handover**

1. The Contractor undertakes to execute the Work, i.e. to complete and hand it over in coordination with the above-mentioned co-editor to the Client in the “TO COMPOSITION” or “TO FINALIZATION” phase, via an online service enabling the transfer and delivery of large amounts of data (e.g. Úschovna.cz), with the e-mail address of the person authorized to act in matters of implementation of this contract on behalf of the Client, specified in the header of this contract, no later than on 15 August 2025, in electronic form in doc (or docx) format. The Client, in accordance with Section 1980 par. 2 of the Civil Code, declares that it has no interest in the late performance of the Contractor.
2. The Client will prepare a handover protocol in the form of an e-mail message regarding the handover and acceptance of the Work, i.e. its delivery to the Client in the manner specified in the previous paragraph, through its person authorized to act in matters of implementation of this Contract, specified in its header, which will be sent to the Contractor's e-mail address specified in the header of this Contract.
3. The handover protocol will contain the scope of the Work being handed over. Furthermore, in the handover protocol, the Client may notify the Contractor of any defects in the Work, which the Contractor undertakes to remove and/or eliminate no later than 5 days from the date of sending the email message with the handover protocol by the Client to the Contractor.
4. The Contractor is obliged to confirm receipt of the above-mentioned handover protocol by email by sending an email message to the email address of the person authorized to act on behalf of the Client in matters of implementation of this contract specified in the header of this contract.

**III.**  
**Price for the Work**

1. The Contracting Parties have agreed that for the proper and timely performance of the Work, the Contractor shall be entitled to the price in the amount of **19 010 CZK**. Contractor is not a VAT payer.
2. The above-mentioned price for the Work includes all costs of the Contractor associated with the performance of the Work and its profit; beyond this price, no further monetary or material performance will be provided to the Contractor by the Client.
3. The Client undertakes to pay the price for the Work on the basis of this contract, within 21 days from the date of delivery of the confirmation of acceptance of the handover protocol by the Contractor within the meaning of Article II. paragraphs 3 and 4 of this contract.
4. The price for the Work is considered to be paid on the date of debiting the price for the Work from the Client's bank account to the Contractor's bank account, as these accounts are listed in the header of this contract.

**IV.**  
**Sanctions**

1. In the event of the Client's delay in paying the price for the Work under this contract within the due date specified in Article III. paragraph 3, the Client is obliged to pay the Contractor interest on delay in the amount specified in Government Regulation No. 351/2013 Coll.
2. In the event that the Contractor fails to fulfill its contractual obligation to deliver the completed Work within the agreed time of performance stipulated in Article II. paragraph 1 of this contract, the Contractor is obliged to pay the Client a contractual penalty of CZK 100 for each day of delay, including any commenced day, in fulfilling this obligation.
3. In the event that the Contractor fails to remove and/or eliminate the defects of the Work claimed by the Client within the period stipulated in Article II. paragraph 3. of this contract, the contractor is obliged to pay the client a contractual penalty of CZK 100 for each day of delay in removing the defect/defects, even if it has been commenced.
4. The agreement on contractual penalties in accordance with the previous paragraphs of this article does not affect the client's right to compensation for damages arising from the breach of obligations confirmed in the previous paragraph of this article in full. The contracting parties exclude the application of Section 2050 of the Civil Code.

**V.**  
**Rights and obligations of the contracting parties, licensing agreements**

1. When performing the Work, the contractor is obliged to comply with all effective legal regulations, ČSN and EN.
2. When performing the Work, the contractor is obliged to refrain from violating and any interference with personal and property copyrights to any copyrighted works.
3. The Contractor undertakes to comply with the instructions of the Client when performing the Work, given through the person authorized to act on behalf of the Client

in matters of implementation of this contract specified in the title of this contract or another authorized employee of the Client.

4. The contracting parties are obliged to inform each other without undue delay of any facts that could have an impact on the performance of this contract.
5. The Contractor declares that, in accordance with Section 1765, paragraph 2 of the Civil Code, he assumes the risk of a change in circumstances. The provisions of Section 1765, paragraph 1 and Section 1766 of the Civil Code therefore do not apply to the Contractor, and the Contractor also assumes the risk of a change in circumstances under this contract within the meaning of Section 2620 of the Civil Code. Therefore, if a completely extraordinary unforeseen circumstance occurs that significantly complicates the completion of the Work under this contract, the Contractor is not entitled to apply to the court to decide, at its discretion, on a fair increase in the price for the Work agreed upon in this contract, or on the cancellation of this contract and on how the parties will settle, and such means cannot be used even if there is a change in circumstances so significant that the change creates a particularly gross disproportion in the rights and obligations of the parties by disadvantaging one of them either by a disproportionate increase in the costs of performance or by a disproportionate decrease in the value of the subject of performance.

## **VI.**

### **Early termination of the obligation**

1. The Contracting Parties are entitled, in addition to legal reasons, in accordance with the provisions of Section 2001 of the Civil Code, to withdraw from this contract as follows:
  - a. The Contractor is entitled to withdraw from this contract in the event of the Customer's delay in paying the price for the Work by more than 20 days compared to the due date specified in Article III. paragraph 3 of this contract;
  - b. the Client is entitled to withdraw from this contract in the event of the contractor's delay in performing the Work exceeding the contractor's performance time agreed in Article II. paragraph 1 of this contract by more than 20 days.
2. The effects of withdrawal from the contract shall occur on the date of delivery of the written notice of withdrawal to the address of the other contracting party specified in the header of this contract, either in person or through a postal service operator, while the sender is obliged to send the notice of withdrawal from the contract by registered letter with acknowledgment of receipt or have its receipt confirmed in writing by the other contracting party, which undertakes to provide cooperation in this regard and may not refuse to provide confirmation of receipt of any document to the other contracting party.

## **VII.**

### **Final provisions**

1. The binding legal relationship established by this contract is governed by the legal order of the Czech Republic in matters not expressly regulated in this contract, in particular Act No. 89/2012 Coll., Civil Code, as amended.
2. This contract is concluded on the day the parties affixed their signatures hereto and enters into effect on the day of its publication in the Czech Register of Contracts in accordance with the Czech Act No. 340/2015 Coll., as amended. The parties take note

that they will not initiate provision of whatever performance hereunder prior to its effective date.

3. The content of this contract may only be amended by written, dated, sequentially numbered amendments signed by both contracting parties on one document.
4. This contract is made in two copies with the nature of an original, with each contracting party receiving one copy after its conclusion.


