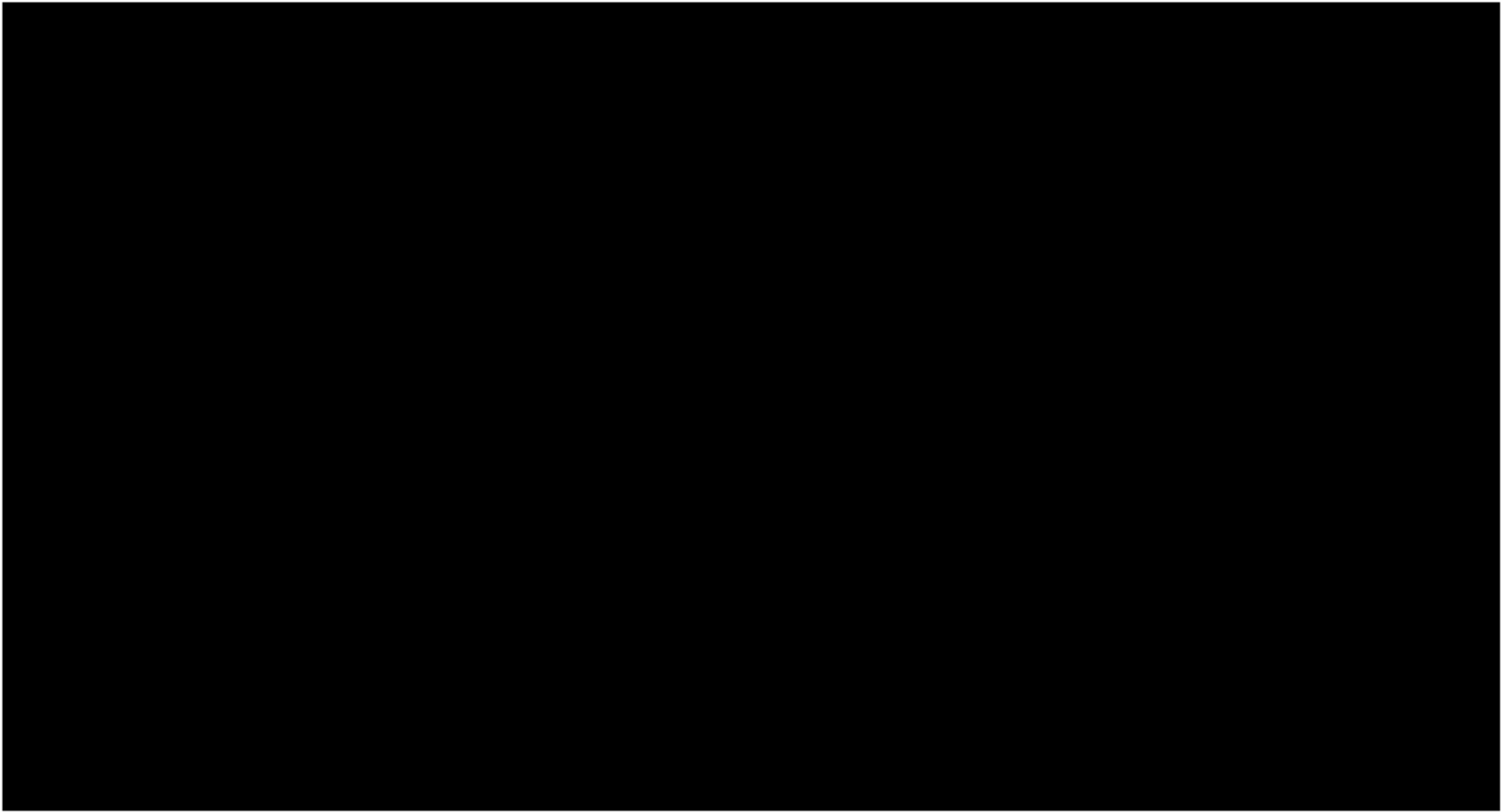
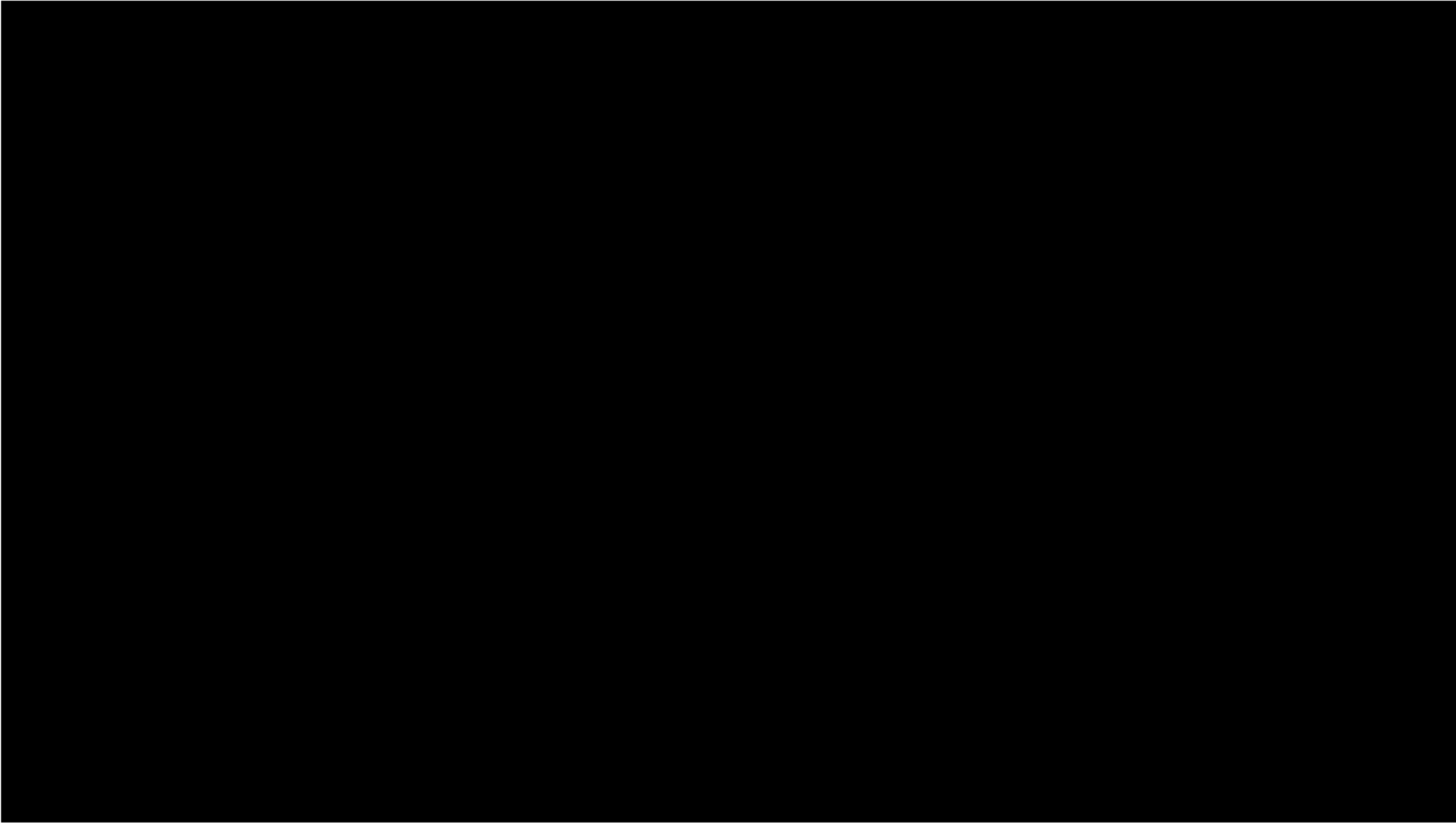

Popis a zdůvodnění Změny:			
Na základě vydaného Opatření obecné povahy ze dne 20.5.2025, které vydala Městská část Praha 6, odbor dopravy, došlo na stavbě, již po její dokončení, ke změně trvalého dopravního značení. Důvodem vzniku byla změna provozu na kompletní jednosměrný provoz v celé délce ulice Jílkova. Původně byl totiž v prvních 20 bm obousměrný provoz. Výjezd z garáží byl umožněn do obou směrů. Nově je přikázaný směr jenom vlevo. Potřebu úpravy dopravního značení potvrdil také i technický dozor ve svém emailovém vyjádření, které je součástí přílohy ZBV. Změny jsou zařazeny podle § 222 odst. 4 ZZVZ, a to vzhledem k tomu, že změny byly zpracované na základě požadavku Městské části, Praha 6.

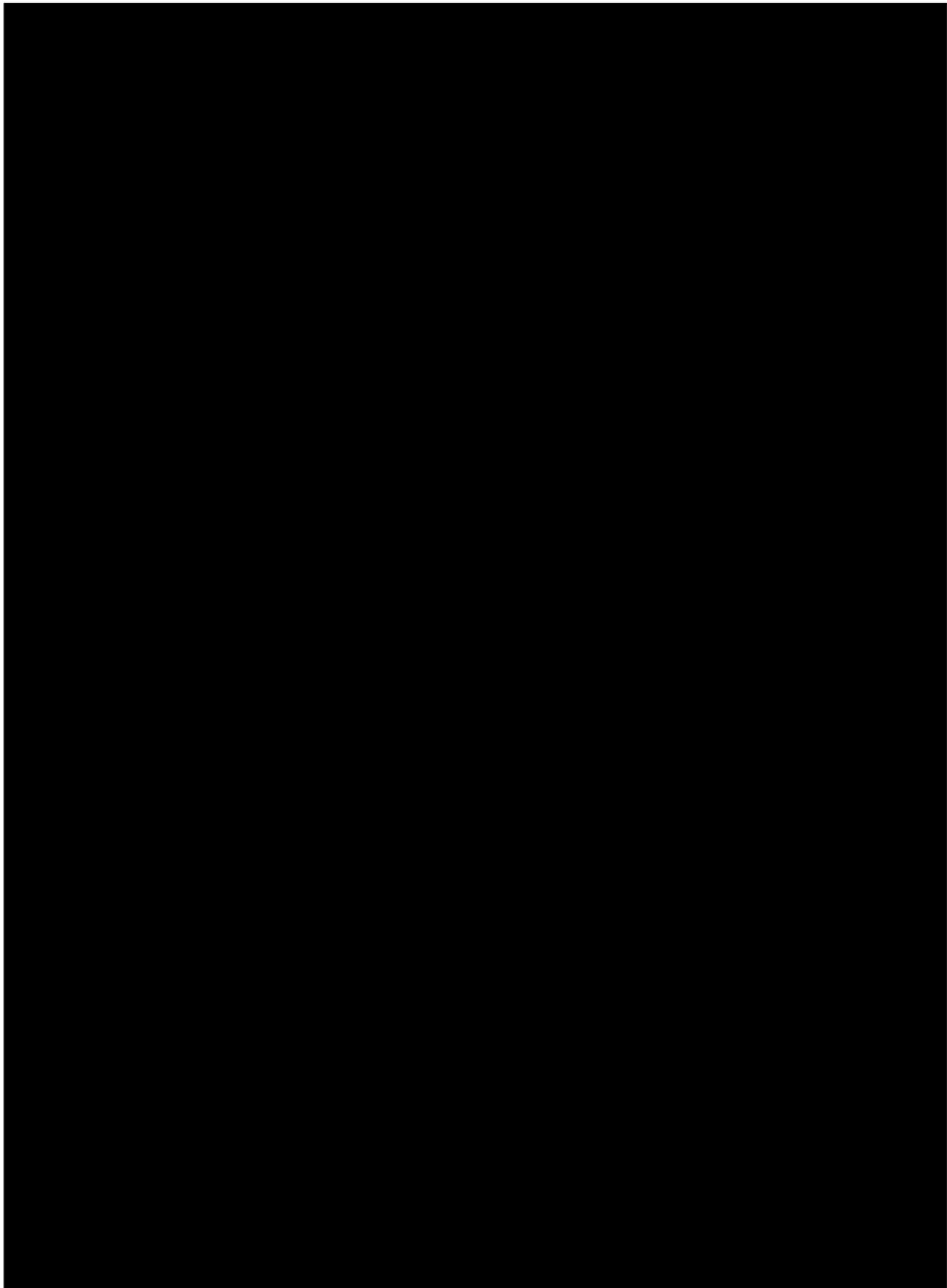
