"After evaluation of the revised manuscript and the detailed responses to both reviewers, I find that the authors have adequately addressed the methodological, analytical, and interpretative concerns originally raised. The statistical procedures have been clarified, the integration between molecular and behavioural findings has been strengthened, and the Discussion has been revised to improve precision and reduce unnecessary speculation. Minor issues regarding terminology, methodological detail, and figure presentation have also been resolved. Although some limitations remain inherent to the correlational nature of the study design, the authors have now appropriately qualified their mechanistic interpretations and contextualised the scope of their conclusions.

On this basis, the manuscript is considered acceptable for publication in its current form."
