called hereafter "**the partner**", represented for the purposes of signature of this agreement by Kaat Torfs, Director.

HAVE AGREED AS FOLLOWS

Art. 1 - Purpose and duration

1.1 The host and the partner have agreed to jointly co- fund the activity **Meeting of ID and Sports Officers of the National Agencies.**

1.2 This current agreement covers the organisational costs of the activity, which will take place on 11-14 May 2026 in Prague, Czechia.

Art. 2 – Financing

2.1 The co- funded contribution enables all parties to undertake the relevant activities and is not seen as a supply for VAT purposes.

2.2 The partner agrees to make a financial contribution to the direct costs related to the overall costs the above-mentioned activity.

2.3 The host and the partner agree that the host will invoice the financial contribution after the event based on final costs. The maximum amount of the financial contribution from

the partner is **850 EUR** per participant, and it covers the accommodation, board and lodging of the participant, conference facilities, and documentation of the event. Travel costs, and board and lodging of participants for extra nights are not covered by this contribution.

2.4 The host will send **3** participant(s) to the event, and therefore the maximum total contribution amounts to **2550 EUR**.

2.5 It is the responsibility of all partners to ensure and keep proof of the co-funding of the activity from other sources than the EU funding.

Art. 3 – Payments

3.1 The partner agrees to pay the amount specified in the final invoice, which will be sent by the DZS after the event, up to a maximum of 850 EUR per participant.

3.2 The partner will pay the amount within 30 days upon a written request for payment or invoice from the host to the partner.

3.3 The partner agrees to pay the amount even if, for any reason, the participants that were selected to participate ultimately do not attend the activity, as the activity needed to be pre-financed by the host, and the costs will be incurred by the host regardless.

Art. 4 – Other provisions

4.1 The host commits itself to undertake the activity in full respect of the Erasmus+ programme regulatory framework, in particular with respect to sound financial management, non-profit, and procurement rules.

4.2 This agreement shall enter into force on the date of the signature of both parties, and it shall enter into effect on the date of the publication in the Register of Contracts in accordance with the relevant provisions of Act No. 340/2015 Sb., on Special Conditions for the Effectiveness of Certain Contracts, Publication of Such Contracts and on the Register of Contracts (Act on the Register of Contracts; hereinafter referred to as the "Act on the Register of Contracts").

4.3 The parties agree that the legal obligation to publish the agreement through the Register of Contracts shall be fulfilled by the host.

4.4 In case of doubt, the parties declare that this agreement does not contain trade secrets, classified information or other information that cannot be published through the Register of Contracts.
