### **I. SDO undertakes:**

1. To perform the production: **The Magic Flute** (opera)  
Date: **2<sup>nd</sup> June 2026**, start at 18:00  
Venue: Gliwice Municipal Theatre, ul. Nowy Świat 55–57  
Performance duration: 170 minutes including intermission  
Number of intermissions: 1
2. To ensure timely transport of performers, stage set, props and costumes.
3. To provide promotional materials (photographs and programmes) upon request.

## II. The Organizer undertakes:

1. To ensure the overall organization and promotion of the performance at its own expense and risk.
2. To ensure the following technical conditions before the performance:
  - a) starting construction and lighting at 17:00 1st of June 2026
  - b) a clean and empty stage from 8:00 (2nd June 2026)
  - c) clean and cleared backstage areas
  - d) dressing rooms for 13 Solo Actors, 38 orchestra members and 26 opera choir with a sufficient number of chairs, hangers, and mirrors
  - e) refreshments for actors, musicians and staff (coffee, water, tea)
  - f) stage rehearsal at 15:00 – 16:30, sound check 16:30 – 17:00
  - g) ACCOMMODATION FOR 10 MEMBERS OF THE TECHNICAL CREW FOR ONE NIGHT (BEFORE)
  - h) 40 free tickets for the production
3. For the performance, SDO provides its own technical staff; the Organizer undertakes, at its own expense, to provide a staff member responsible for the organization of the performance and to ensure the presence of an electrical and audio technician from the arrival of SDO stage technicians until their departure after the performance.
4. To ensure occupational health and safety conditions for performers and operational staff, including fire protection.
5. For productions involving extraordinary stage actions (smoking, open fire, shooting, etc.), an annex forms part of this contract, which the Organizer must accept and ensure all necessary conditions for carrying out such actions.
6. To prevent access of unauthorized persons to backstage areas and to ensure protection of SDO property.
7. To ensure parking for a truck, a transporter and two buses, including free access for stage decorations (arrival, access to the stage).
8. To ensure a ban on audio and video recordings during the performance (exceptions may only be granted by the SDO tour manager).
9. To pay SDO, upon receipt of invoice, the agreed price: CZK 80,000 (in words: eighty thousand Czech crowns) + CZK 40,000 (in words: forty thousand Czech crowns) for cargo.
10. Sub-license agreement and agreement on the assumption of obligations: SDO grants the Organizer a sub-license to stage the above-mentioned performance.

### III. Cancellation and amendments to the contract:

1. If the performance does not take place as a result of a breach of the contract by the Organizer, the Organizer is obliged to reimburse SDO for all costs associated with the preparation of the performance (transport, travel expenses, etc.) and the agreed performance fee.
2. If the Organizer is unable to hold the performance at the place and time according to this contract for any reason, SDO agrees that the performance may take place on the same day at an alternative venue, provided that all other conditions of this contract are met.
3. If the performance does not take place due to the fault of SDO, SDO shall reimburse the Organizer for all demonstrable costs associated with securing the performance or provide a substitute performance on an agreed date.

### IV. Final provisions:

1. Legal relations between SDO and the Organizer are governed by Act No. 89/2012 Coll., the Civil Code.
2. This contract becomes valid upon signature by the authorized representatives of the contracting parties and becomes effective upon its publication in the Register of Contracts. Any amendments or additions must be made in writing and signed by both parties.
