I. Introductory Provisions

1. WIS is an institute for higher education and a scientific research institution providing postgraduate education. WIS together with the Academy of Sciences of the Czech Republic, residing at Národní 3, 117 20 Prague 1 (further referred to as "ASCR"), launched a call for applications for a 3-year postdoctoral fellowship at WIS – "Fellowship Opportunities for Postdoctoral Fellows at the Weizmann Institute of Science" (more details on the terms and conditions, see [REDACTED]

2. HIPC is a scientific institution established by the ASCR, the employee of which [REDACTED]

III. Final provisions

1. Both parties have agreed that this Agreement shall be governed by the Czech law, especially by Czech Civil Code (act no. 89/2012Coll).
2. Both parties hereby agree to publish this Agreement in Register of agreements led by Ministry of interior of The Czech Republic according to act no. 340/2015Coll. (hereinafter referred to as "the register of agreements"). HIPC is obliged to publish this Agreement and inform WIS about it.
3. This Agreement enters in force and effect by its publication in the register of agreements.
4. All changes or additions of this Agreement must be done in written form and signed by authorized representatives of both parties. This Agreement has been drawn, with consent of both parties, in the English language only. Each agreeing party shall obtain one copy of the Agreement.
5. It is the intention of the Parties to resolve all matters amicably in accordance with this paragraph. Any dispute which may arise concerning this Agreement will first be submitted for resolution to the persons named below, who may call on others to advise them as they see fit:

II. Subject Matter of the Agreement

1. On November 2, 2017, based on the results of the common call of the ASCR and WIS for applications for the Fellowship approved by the Academic Council of the ASCR (at its 7th meeting of October 3, 2017), HIPC received from the ASCR one-time funding corresponding to the agreement with WIS, which should serve to cover half of the expenses for the Recipient's Fellowship.
2. HIPC is bound to transfer to the WIS Bank [REDACTED] without undue delay after the date of entering in force of this Agreement.
3. According to the agreement with the ASCR, WIS is bound to disburse the full Sum corresponding to half of the expenses for the Fellowship to the Recipient along with the other half amounting to **USD 52,950.00** from its own sources by the date and under the conditions agreed between the Recipient and WIS. The total amount of the Fellowship expenses is **USD 105,900.00**.
4. The funding specified in Sections II.2. and II.3. above shall be provided to the Recipient for covering the costs associated with her stay at WIS and for the Recipient's participation at conferences during her stay at WIS. WIS shall provide HIPC once a year (till December, 31 of respective year of Fellowship) with outline including expenses paid (deducted) from the Sum in relation with Fellowship.
5. After the expiration of agreed period of Fellowship, WIS shall submit to HIPC final account proving the use of Sum paid by HIPC. If there is a balance of Sum, WIS shall refund it on HIPC's bank account within 15 days following submission of final account.
6. The Recipient's Fellowship at WIS shall be subject to the terms and conditions applicable at WIS for awarding the Fellowship. It is agreed that in case of an early termination of the Recipient's stay at WIS, WIS will refund HIPC the balance of the Sum that has not yet been paid to the Recipient to the account [REDACTED] without undue delay following termination of the Recipient's stay at WIS. HIPC shall then transfer the reimbursement from WIS to the ASCR account. This shall be conveyed to the Recipient by WIS.
7. For excluding doubt, it has been agreed that HIPC shall not be liable for the content and observance of the agreement concluded between WIS and the Recipient. For excluding doubt, HIPC **shall not be responsible** for any loss or damage caused by the Recipient during her stay at WIS.
8. WIS is obliged to immediately inform HIPC about all cases of termination or suspension of Recipient's Fellowship in WIS. Along with such information, WIS shall mention the reason for which the Fellowship was terminated or suspended.
9. The parties have agreed that in all works (including books and publications) to be performed by Recipient during her Fellowship will explicitly acknowledge a support and contribution from The Czech Academy of Sciences, J. Heyrovský Institute of Physical Chemistry of the CAS, v. v. i., Dolejškova 3/2155, 182 00 Prague 8, Czech Republic.
