





- Students must be nominated through Palacký University on-line system. The institutional coordinator and the person responsible for student mobilities will receive information about the nomination procedure and access to the system at least three months before the deadline.

- Incoming students are allowed to take courses in other study fields but they are requested to take the majority of courses in the study area mentioned in this agreement.
- The partner university is kindly requested to ensure that the language proficiency of the outgoing student(s) is a minimum B2.
- Students are offered a Czech language course throughout the semester.
- Academic staff interested in a teaching visit at UP should contact the relevant department.
- Non-academic staff members interested in spending a training week at UP should contact the International Office . A proposal of the Mobility Agreement is also required.



E. Calendar

1. Applications/information on nominated students must reach the receiving institution by:

- 2. A SALZBUR01 will send its decision within 4 weeks after the application deadline.
 - CZ OLOMOUC01: The receiving institutions will send their decisions within 6 weeks after deadline.
- A SALZBUR01: A Transcript of Records will be issued no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished and provided through the intranet platform PLUSonline. Each student can print out the transcript of records personally.
 - CZ OLOMOUCO1: A transcript of records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 6 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.





4. Termination of the agreement: This Agreement will be effective when the representatives of both institutions affix their signatures to it. It shall stay in effect for the time period stated above. It may be subject to revision or modification from time to time by mutual agreement including the attachment of additional schedules as they are developed. Either party reserves the right to terminate this Agreement upon twelve months' written notice to the other party. In this case, the program(s) or the activity(ies) already approved by both parties shall be allowed to be completed under the conditions of this agreement. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.




