- A Transcript of Records will be issued by I CAGLIAR01 no later than 4 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 4. Termination of the agreement

The agreement will become operative on the date of signature of both universities and shall remain in force for a period of **6 years**. In case of the termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be sent to the partner university. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

I CAGLIAR01: Subject units are generally taught for one semesters. Final assessment of the student is based on the result of one or more examinations, which may be oral and/or written. The pass mark for examinations is 18 out of 30. The highest mark for examinations is 30 out of 30. An excellent performance is usually graded above 28.

ECTS grading scale: A= 30 e 30 cum laude; B:27/28/29; C: 24/25/26; D = 21/22/23 E: 18/19/20; F: fail (see: http://www.unica.it/pub/english/index.jsp?is=23&iso=380).
