- Application documents received after application deadlines will not be accepted.
- In case, if the application documents are't in Slovak, English or Czech language, the applicant have to add the authorized translation of these documents.
- Exchange studies for PhD students are organized according to individual plans.
- It is not possible for exchange students fo defend ther BA/MA/PfD thesis at the host university.
- Incoming international staff members shold apply for visits to the departamental coordinators of the respective fakulty (<u>http://unipo.sk/en/en/internationa-relations/staffmobility</u>)
- Applicants with special needs will be contacted before the final approval of the acceptance. Final decision depends on extra services/facilities available

- 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 6 weeks.
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 6 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.

CZ OSTRAVA02: Transcripts of records are issued by the International Office immediately after the examination period and handed to the incoming students before their departure

- 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 4 weeks.
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution upon the student's departure or, in any case, no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. [It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]
- 4. Termination of the agreement

Either party can terminate the agreement by informing the other party expressly in writing. In case of a unilateral termination of the agreement, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. Students selected prior the date of notification must be admitted by the receiving institution. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of conflict.
