Inter-institutional agreement 2018-19* between programme countries

[Minimum requirements]

**It is understood that the implementation of this Agreement will commence on the day of signature, and will continue thereafter for six years, subject from time to time revision or modification by mutual agreement. Representatives from both institutions will discuss the terms of a renewal, and either party must give the other party no less than one year (academic year) notice in writing of intention to either revise or terminate this Agreement before its natural termination.*

The institutions named below agree to cooperate for the exchange of students and/or staff in the context of the Erasmus+ programme. They commit to respect the quality requirements of the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education in all aspects related to the organisation and management of the mobility, in particular the recognition of the credits awarded to students by the partner institution.

It is renewable for another academic year upon mutual consent from the each party. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.





